2015 Advance Notice of AGM and Election of Board Members

If you want to submit a resolution and have it included in the notice of the AGM, please send it to me by October 17th and include the wording of the resolution and the names, membership numbers, email addresses and/or phone numbers of the members who are proposing and seconding the resolution.

If you wish to stand for election to the trust board, you need to:

- be a paid-up member of Blues Trust,
- be nominated by two other members of the trust.
- submit a nomination and a statement in support of it no later than October 17th, 2015.
